Tempo: quarter note = 140




EXCERPT #2

Tempo: quarter note = 80















EXCERPT #3

SOURCE: Franck, Symphony in D minor, Mvt III.

Tempo: half note = 124



SCALES

Select 3 scales from those listed below to play for your video; At least 1 should be a chromatic scale through your range (start at your lowest note and play to your highest note and back down).

Up to 4 sharps & 4 flats Major

- C Major; G Major; D Major; A Major; E Major; F Major; Bb Major; Eb Major; Ab Major
- o 2 Octaves
- o Memorization preferred
- o Chromatic scale through your range

SOLO
