

CONCERT ORCHESTRA Audition Requirements

Students auditioning for Symphony Orchestra should perform the following for the audition video **in the order** listed below.

1. Excerpts – 1

2. Solo

- a. select a solo or a part of a solo that is 3-4 minutes long that best shows your skills and musicality at this time.

WHEN YOU ARE READY TO RECORD, Record in the following Order:

- 1. Announce your FIRST and LAST NAME, your INSTRUMENT and that you are auditioning for CONCERT ORCHESTRA.**
- 2. Play your excerpt.**

Chord symbols in the second system: F#m, Bm, Dm, Gm, F#m, Cm, Dm.

Chord symbols in the third system: Cm, Bm, Dm, A#m, Dm, Bm, Gm, A#m.

3. ANNOUNCE THE TITLE and COMPOSER of your SOLO and then perform it.

- Select a solo, or a passage of a solo, that best represents your skills at the time of the audition. About 3-4 total minutes of music.
- On your video, announce the title of the solo and the composer.
- Keep in mind that you have to upload your full audition video to YouTube, so the longer solo you play, the longer it may take to upload your video.

4. When your video is complete, UPLOAD your video to YouTube and create an “Unlisted” video (instructions at the QR code below). Once it is ready, copy your video link.

5. Visit the CKYO Audition Application form to give us your information and paste your audition video link. There is a \$20 audition application fee. If you need help with the fee, send us an email at ckyo@ckyo.org.
